The meeting was called to order in the village council chambers by President Sullivan at 6:00PM.

A **risk reduction grant** through the Michigan Township Participating Plan is available for a Taser 10 for the police department. The grant is for \$5000. The village would have to pay \$1650 up front. A motion was made by Carlson and seconded by Erickson to approve the resolution of support to submit an application to the Michigan Township Par Plan. Carr4ed 4-0.

Northern Michigan University is offering a one-week **CDL course**. Two new DPW employees will be attending. A motion was made by Galbraith and seconded by Erickson to pay the \$2450/employee fee to attend the class and pay their wages for the week. A two-year employment commitment is expected or the cost of the class will need to be reimbursed to the village. Housing and meals are the responsibility of the employee. Carried 4-0.
